



Dear PipeStone Golf Club Members and Guests,

I hope you are well, staying safe and following the CDC/WHO guidelines. The Club has made the below operational updates to ensure protocols are in place for the safety of our Members, Guests and Team Members.

As of May 2nd, Golf Carts will be available with the following restrictions!

- Maximum 1 player per Golf Cart (except for those living in the same household).
- Carts with a sanitized tag are the only carts available.
- Carts are available on a first come, first served basis.
- Tee times have been extended to 12 minutes.
- All carts are to remain on the path unless a valid BMV handicap placard is presented.
- Walking is still available and recommended for those able.
- Social distancing is to be used at all times.

Booking and payment will remain online only.

We appreciate your patience as we navigate through these unprecedented times. The Club will continue to send updates based on any CDC/WHO guideline changes that may arise. We consider you and our Team Members as part of a large family and safety remains our top priority. We are in the business of serving all of our Members and Guests and in the midst of this COVID-19 pandemic, it's important that we still provide you with a place to relax and enjoy the Club you call home while, at the same time, providing our Team Members a safe place to work. It's also important that we give you as much information as possible about the procedures we follow to clean the Club and maintain a sanitary environment for you based on information from the CDC and WHO, federal agencies and other health organizations.

Below you'll find a few of the steps we are taking:

- We have updated all cleaning procedures to ensure they meet or exceed all CDC guidelines. Hard surfaces such as bathrooms, tables, windows and handrails are thoroughly wiped down with a high-grade disinfectant and multi-purpose cleaner.
- Golf Carts contact points are being sanitized with each use.
- All flag sticks should remain in the hole and go untouched.
- We have removed all bunker rakes from the Course, please just smooth over the spot in which you last hit from with your feet.
- All cups have been altered so that you do not have to reach down into the hole for the golf ball.
- Water coolers have been removed from the Golf Course.
- Self-serve ice/water station has been shut off.
- Ball washers have been removed from the Golf Course.
- Team Members are wearing latex gloves as they are making transactions.
- Team Member health screenings will take place upon arrival to work. Team Members have been asked to stay home if they are not feeling well.
- COVID-19 prevention notices are posted in the Clubhouse and on the Golf Course.
- Lastly, we should not be shaking hands with anybody at this time, please do not take offense as this is important to limit contact with each other.

Thank you for your understanding as the Club implements further safety measures and for doing your part in keeping fellow Members and Guests safe!
